Joe Morgan moved with his family from Bonham, Texas, to Oakland when he was 5. Growing up in Oakland, Morgan was often overlooked because of his small stature. He was a high school star at Castlemont, but at 5-foot-5, 140 pounds, most scouts didn't consider him someone worth pursuing before going on to a Hall of Fame baseball career. He was a key player from Cincinnati's "Big Red Machine" in the 70s. A family spokesman says he died Sunday at his home in Danville.
